### Worktrip

Each summer, high school students have the opportunity to go on a week long mission trip where you can make a real difference! Students have the time of their life, meet new friends and deeper their current friendships. Youth from St. Paul's join hundreds of other youth from around the country, of all denominations and are put into work crews of 5-6 people. These crews work on homes for disadvantaged people in the community. The work generally consists of winterizing homes, painting and light carpentry. This is an amazing opportunity for all youth and their friends. Worktrip meetings and fundraising kick off in September.



### Volunteer Opportunities

High school students have the opportunity to volunteer in several ways throughout the year. They have the opportunity to assist in a Sunday school classroom or the nursery during the school year.
