



Scripture: Isaiah 55:1-9

Thoughts: Isaiah 55:vs. 1: "Come all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money , come buy, and eat!"

Vs. 8 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."

God opens to us an invitation to be in a living covenant with Him. Come to the Lord while there is still yet time. We would be remiss not to accept the life-giving message from God to join with Him in a covenant relationship. All we need to do is ask in prayer to be in relationship with Him, and it is to be. Praise the Lord that God's thoughts and ways are higher than ours. Just reach out to the Lord and open our hearts to His love.

Discussion: How do we decipher God's will from the simplest to the most complex problems that come our way?

Spend time in thought , prayer, and meditation on God's ways. Meditate on God's ways and how we might rise to emulate His ways. What can we do in our daily lives to become change agents, to be in relationship with others and with God?

Activities: Think of some concrete ways to be change agents in our daily life: Habitat for Humanity contributions; washing windows for an elderly neighbor; baking cookies for the Homebound; calling a hurting friend; enriching our relationship with God; and praying for opportunities to show others God's love.
