## **St. Paul's Scholarship Requirements for Qualification**

The St. Paul's Scholarship was created to provide scholarships to members of St. Paul's UMC who have demonstrated service to the church and/or community. Scholarships in the amount of \$500 or more may be used by the recipient(s) to assist with tuition and/or room and board at an accredited college/university, vocational program, apprenticeship, or training program. Scholarship funds awarded will be issued to the institution and recipient (dual payee).

Persons applying for this scholarship must meet all of the following requirements:

1. Must be a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church at the time of application.
2. Must identify service efforts provided to the church and/or community.
3. Must be a high school senior or graduate, or must possess a GED certificate.
4. Must have a minimum grade point average of 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0).
5. Provide a current copy of transcript and/or GED certificate.
6. Provide two letters of recommendation dated after September 1 of the preceding year, and not by family members or St. Paul's staff. The recommendations should specify current activities to support the application.
7. Write a short essay as described on the application form.
8. Students can reapply each year of their education.
